

Environmental Educator

The Waccamaw Watershed Academy within the Burroughs and Chapin Center for Marine and Wetland Studies seeks to hire an Environmental Educator. The Environmental Educator will develop, deliver and assess environmental education programs to be based at a new facility located at Waites Island. These programs are targeted at pre-college students and public outreach. Half of this staff person's efforts would be dedicated to delivery of educational services for local NPDES Phase II stormwater program permit compliance as prioritized by the local stormwater managers. The Educator will also play a leadership role in development of a regional environmental education plan involving other institutions and agencies. Other responsibilities will include marketing of education programs, enrollment management, development and administration of grants, personnel management, and collaborating with faculty. This is a full-time, renewable academic staff contract (12 month). The successful applicant will have a strong background in natural science/ natural resources including marine science. Excellent oral, written, and interpersonal communication skills are required. A Masters Degree or equivalent experience preferred.
