

NEW YORK HARBOR SCHOOL
IMMEDIATE TEACHER VACANCY – EXCITING FIELD POSITION

New York Harbor School, a new, maritime-themed, public high school, seeks a full-time educator for the remainder of the school year to co-teach an experiential science class with a New York State certified teacher. This is a short term position – from April 4th- June 28th, with the possibility of becoming long term at the Harbor School.

“Introduction to New York Harbor” is a scientific, cultural and historical analysis of New York Harbor and the various water bodies that make up the estuary. Students visit different sections of the estuary, meeting environmentalists, boat builders and others who work on the water; studying specific scientific concepts; and comparing and contrasting the water bodies in terms of their physical make-up, their ecology and their environmental issues.

Duties include curriculum planning and writing, scheduling and coordinating with community-based organizations, delivering lessons, and assessing student work. Applicants should be comfortable traveling with students on public transportation and being on and around water with students. Applicants must have good student management skills as well as good overall organizational skills.
