**HOURS/SALARY:**

Per diem educators are part-time Museum employees. Hours generally consist of weekday mornings, averaging 2 days per week. Pay rate is \$15 per hour for a minimum of four hours; training rate is \$9 per hour.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Per diem educators are responsible for teaching programs to visiting school groups, afterschool programs, and other youth and community organizations. Lesson plans and training will be provided. All programs are designed to utilize a variety of activities and teaching techniques.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Applicants should have an undergraduate degree, museum or education-related fields preferred. Experience working with children in an educational setting required. A successful candidate must be outgoing and confident teaching in both traditional and museum classroom environments.
