

Six Flags Marine World Seafari Day Camp Camp Director

POSITION TITLE: Camp Director (seasonal)

DEPARTMENT: Education

BASIC FUNCTION: Manages day-to-day operations of the summer day camp program, including supervision of camp staff, communicating with families of enrolled campers, and managing daily activity schedules and camp supplies. Develops program content and assists with program registration. Responsible preparing the final camp report.

PRIMARY JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Manages day-to-day operations of camp, including camper arrival and dismissal, keeper requests and craft and activity preparation.
2. Assists Education Supervisor with management of camp staff, including weekly meetings, evaluations and daily supervision.
3. Develops program content for specific age groups including, related activities and projects.
4. Assists the Education Supervisor with monitoring camp expenses against established budget. Orders and organizes all daily camp supplies such as arts and craft supplies, snacks, and games.
5. Interacts on a daily basis with camper parents and guardians and answers questions or concerns and addressing discipline issues, etc.
6. Acts as substitute camp counselor during counselor absences. Assists Education Department programs as needed.
7. Assists with program registration, when needed.
8. Other related duties as assigned.

POSITION REQUIREMENT AND SPECIFICATIONS:

- Minimum two years of college course work in education or biology or related field, or equivalent combination of training and experience required.
- Minimum one year of supervisory experience required.
- Minimum one year of experience teaching children in a formal setting such as an elementary school, and/or a non-formal education setting such as a museum, nature center, or zoo required.
- Must possess excellent organizational and communications skills.
- Proven ability to supervise staff in a demanding setting. Must be highly flexible.
- Must represent Six Flags Marine World in a professional, courteous manner at all times.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This seasonal position requires a self-starter who is able to work independently. Applicant must be enthusiastic and able to maintain a positive work environment. Must be an energetic and flexible team

player and able to work in a fast-paced environment. Seafari Camp Director may also assist with other Education programs offered at Six Flags Marine World. Applicant is expected to incorporate knowledge of Six Flags Marine World, its mission, vision and values into daily operations and job responsibilities. Applicant is also expected to become familiar with and follow all Park policies and procedures. Camp Director must represent Six Flags Marine World in a professional, courteous manner at all times including interactions with campers, camp staff, families of enrolled campers, and Park guests.
