**Join us for a Bay Beach Cleanup**

**September 16<sup>th</sup> 2006: Tobay Beach, South Oyster Bay**

**Background:**

Each year thousands of volunteers participate in the American Littoral Society's New York State Beach Cleanup Day. Last year over 7,700 volunteers cleaned and documented over 215,000 pounds of debris at 312 beaches throughout NY.

This is *Long Island South Shore Estuary Reserve's* fourth year collaboratively managing a cleanup of Tobay Beach's bay beach and wetlands. This cleanup is part of our efforts to raise public awareness of the Reserve's vast natural resources and ways to protect them.

**Purpose:**

- To clean the beach and document what litters our shores
- To compile data to devise strategies to combat pollution
- To increase public participation in solving the problem of pollution
- To increase public awareness and appreciation of the coastal environment

The beach cleanup will be from 10:00am – 1:00pm.  
We will be meeting at 10:00 in the Tobay Beach bay parking lot.

It is suggested you bring a hat, sunscreen, bug spray, wear old sneakers or secure shoes that can get wet and if possible, work gloves,

**Directions:**

**From Western Long Island**, the Meadowbrook Parkway (South) or the Wantagh Parkway (South) lead into Ocean Parkway. Once on Ocean Parkway continue East towards Jones Beach. Continue approximately 4.2 miles East of Jones Beach Water Tower. Stay in left lane and make U-turn at sign to reach the bay side of Tobay Beach.

**From Eastern Long Island**, take either the Southern State Parkway or the Sagtikos Parkway to The Robert Moses Causeway. The Robert Moses Causeway runs into Ocean Parkway. Take Ocean Parkway West, towards Jones Beach. Tobay Beach is on your right (North side) as soon as you cross over into Nassau County. BE ALERT, there is no sign for Tobay going West on Ocean Parkway.
