

## Flight Information and Directions to the LIU Campus

When making your flight arrangements, keep in mind that there are three major airports you can fly into. From each airport, you may either get to LIU (Brooklyn Campus) by bus/subway, or you can take a taxi. The airports and taxi rates are:

LaGuardia Airport (LGA)	Approximately \$35 to LIU
Kennedy Airport (JFK)	Approximately \$40 to LIU
Newark Airport (EWR)	Approximately \$50 to LIU

**Save Money!** If you fly into JFK, you can take the Airtrain bus (\$5) to the A train, and then take the A train (\$2) to Hoyt-Schermerhorn Street Station. This trip can take 60-90 minutes. It's then about a 10-minute walk to the LIU campus.

You can also save money by taking a bus (about \$7 from Newark, \$9 from LaGuardia, and \$13 from JFK) to **Port Authority Bus Terminal** (the trip will take 60-90 minutes), and then getting yourself to LIU by one of three ways:

1. **Taxi** (approximately \$25); or
2. The **A Subway** Downtown to Hoyt Schermerhorn Street Station (\$2). You will then have about a 10-minute walk to the LIU campus; or
3. The **2 or 3 Subway** Downtown to Nevins Street Station (\$2). You have to walk about 5 minutes from the bus terminal to connect to the 2/3 train, but you'll have a much shorter walk from Nevins Street to LIU (about 2 minutes).

Alternatively, you can take a bus from each airport to **Grand Central Terminal** (again, about \$7 to \$13), and then get to LIU by one of two ways:

1. **Taxi** (approximately \$20); or
2. The Downtown **4 or 5 Subway** (\$2) to Nevins Street Station. You will then have about a 2-minute walk to LIU.

In each airport, stop at the Ground Transportation desk to ask bus travel directions and to buy your bus ticket.

If you take a **taxi from LaGuardia**, these are the directions to give the driver:

Take the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway west to the Tillary Street Exit. Follow Tillary Street to Flatbush Avenue. Make a left onto Flatbush Avenue. The LIU Campus is on the corner of Flatbush and DeKalb Avenues.

If you take a **taxi from JFK**, these are the directions to give the driver:

Take the Belt Parkway to the Brooklyn Queens Expressway east to the Tillary Street Exit. Follow Tillary Street to Flatbush Avenue. Make a left onto Flatbush Avenue. The LIU Campus is on the corner of Flatbush and DeKalb Avenues.

If you take a **taxi from Newark**, these are the directions to give the driver:

Take the Holland Tunnel into Manhattan and the Brooklyn Bridge into Brooklyn. As you come off the bridge, stay straight until you reach the first traffic light. At the light, turn left onto Tillary St. and then right on Flatbush Avenue. The LIU Campus is on the left.

If you take a **taxi from the Port Authority or Grand Central**, these are the directions to give the driver:

Take the Brooklyn Bridge. As you come off the bridge, stay straight until you reach the first traffic light. At the light, turn left onto Tillary St. and then right on Flatbush Avenue. The LIU Campus is on the left.
